A tornado occurred at CONSTABLE, NEW YORK on August 21st. 1823.

Entered from Canada, path S.E. Two paths seemed to unite. ~~Rxxxx~~ Finally moved in spiral paths through orchard. F HOUGH, HISTORY ST. LAWRENCE and FRANKLIN COUNTIES. 697-698.

CONSTABLE situated 5 miles south of the Canadian border, 22 miles E.S.E. of CORNWALL.
