




Ward's Island: ethnic origins




Visible minority population in St Lawrence-East Bayfront-The Islands (166): 43% Visible minority population in City of Toronto: 51%




Language: Scarborough Village



Accessibility: Ward's island and Scarborough Village.




Top-5 non-English home languages in Scarborough Village




