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PREFACE

The 28th meeting of the Austronesian Formal Linguistics Association (AFLA) was jointly organized by McGill University and the National University of Singapore and was held online on May 25-28, 2022. The AFLA 28 program included 23 regular talks – chosen from 34 abstracts received – as well as invited talks by Victoria Chen, Jed Pizarro-Guevara, Vololona Razafimbelo, Jozina Vander Klok, and Sam Zukoff. Like AFLAs that came before, talks spanned the Austronesian world and included many works by junior scholars as well as native speaker linguists. Participants from around the world participated the sessions in real time, with others engaging with the recorded talks posted to YouTube.¹
