STORM WREAKS MUCH DAMAGE

Three-Mile Swath Cut
Through Two Townships

CROPS ARE LEVELLED

Alvinston, July 28 (CP) -- Cutting a three-mile swath through part of Enniskillen and Brooke Townships, a violent storm this afternoon levelled crops, ripped up orchards, lifted roofs off barns and knocked down many buildings.

The storm broke about 1:30 in the afternoon. In Enniskillen Township about one mile east of the Brooke Line, a violent wind picked the roof off the barn of Fred Miner, levelled what crops were standing and ripped up many trees.

Although the storm headed directly east, there was no damage to the next two farms. Then the wind seemed to strike again on the Springstead farm. There a large barn on an eight-foot wall was completely wrecked. Other frame buildings on the farm were also knocked down. Wreckage from the Springstead buildings was scattered for half a mile.

There was little serious damage for the next mile and then the storm hit the farm of John Chapman in Brooke Township. Part of a metal roof on the Chapman barn was lifted off by the wind and pieces of steel were scattered over farms for two miles. Further east the roof was torn off the barn of Charles McCabe in Brooke.
