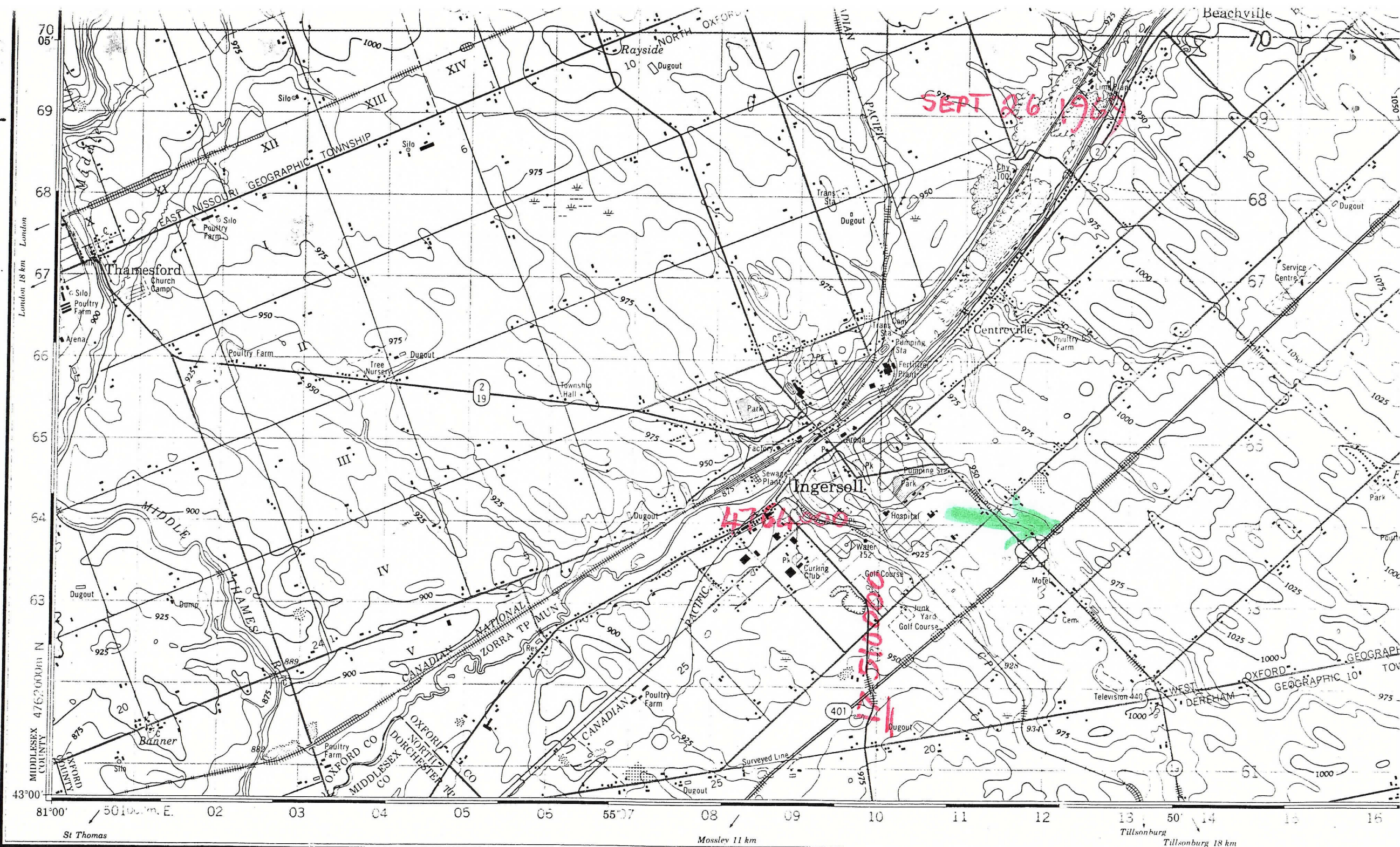

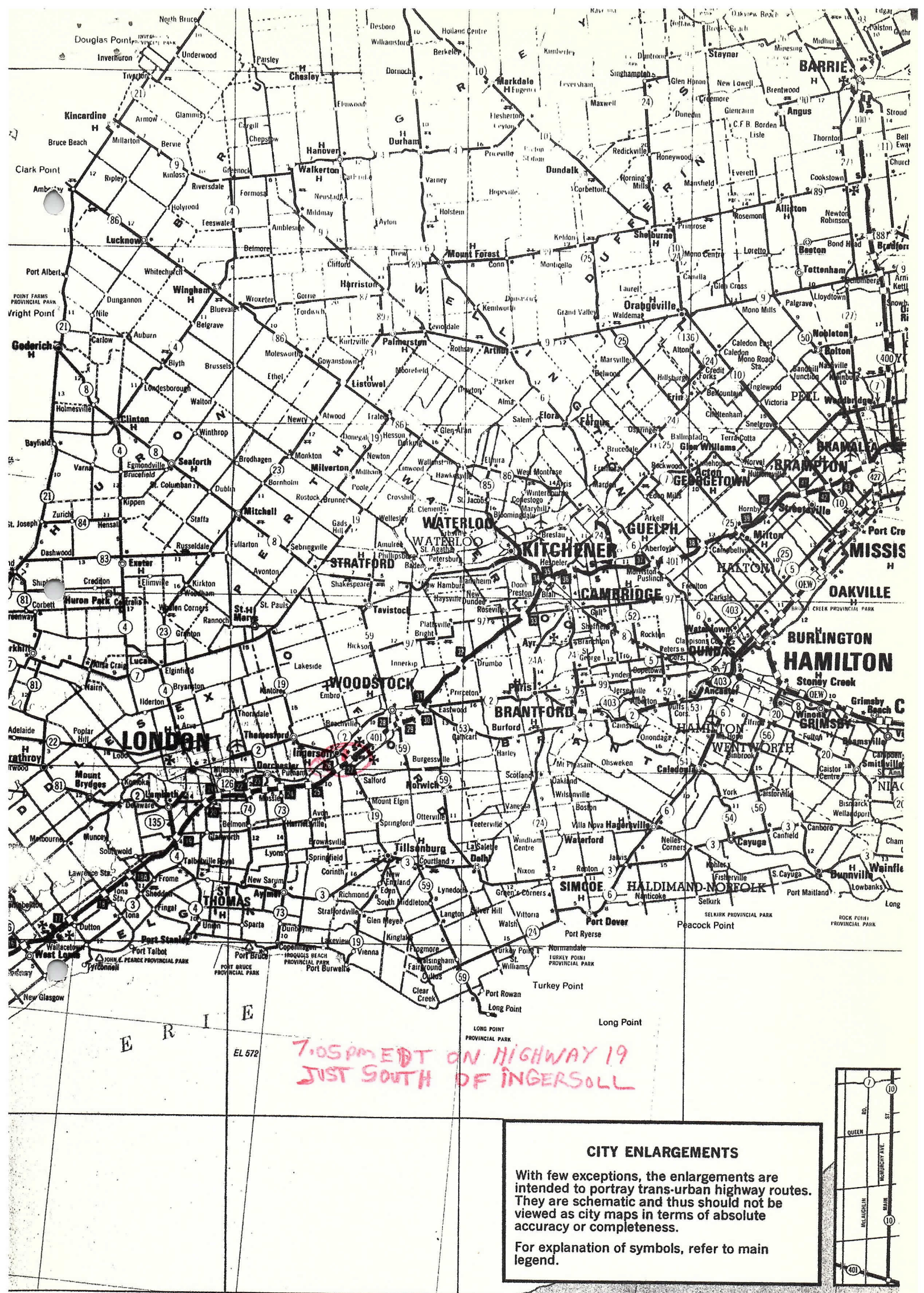

PICNIC TABLES WHICH HAD BEEN OUTSIDE THE RESTAURANT WERE CARRIED ACROSS HIGHWAY 19 INTO AN OPEN FIELD  
JOHN VAN DYKE OF INGERSOLL OWNER OF THE RESTAURANT SAID:  
THE PATRONS AND EMPLOYEES BEGAN TO GET SUSPICIOUS WHEN THE DOORS BEGAN OPENING AND CLOSING BY THEMSELVES







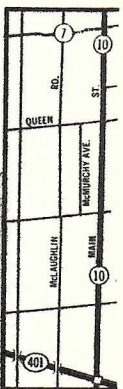
