(a) SEVERAL SIGHTINGS OF FUNNEL CLOUDS NEAR FOREST, PARK HILL, AND IN THE ST MARY'S AREA.

(b) FARM OF BILL FULLER BADLY DAMAGED; ROOF RIPPED OF ONE BARN, TOP TAKEN OFF SILO, REMOVED HALF ROOF OF THE HOUSE, SNAPPED TREES; LIFTED HIS HAY WAGON AND THREW IT ABOUT 75 FEET. BILL FULLER WAS UNLOADING THE WAGON WHEN IT BEGAN TO LIFT, HE JUMPED UNDERNEATH HIS TRACTOR, CLUNG ON FOR ABOUT 5 MINUTES "AND PRAYED FOR ALL I WAS WORTH", SEEING NOTHING BUT FEELING THE FORCE OF THE WIND AROUND HIM. THIS TORNADO TRACK WAS LUCKILY THROUGH LIGHTLY POPULATED COUNTRYSIDE.
