## THE ARTISTS

**The Carnyx Trio** has toured across the southern United States, including performances at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Florida State University, Columbus State University and Troy University. Upcoming tours include tours of Ontario, Colombia and Ecuador. All three members of the Carnyx Trio are committed educators working at leading faculties of music, and their activities regularly include workshops, masterclasses and other teaching.

**Aaron Hodgson** has been praised for his “exquisite musicianship and assured composure” (International Trumpet Guild). A prize-winner in the Ellsworth Smith and OSM Standard Life competitions, Aaron has been recorded for CBC radio, Naxos and Analekta recordings. On faculty at Western University, he holds a Doctor of Musical Arts from Yale University.

Trombonist **Stephen Ivany** is an active performer, clinician and educator across North America. He is the second trombonist with the Teatro Nuovo Opera Orchestra in New York City and regularly performs with the North Carolina Symphony. He is the assistant professor of trombone and euphonium at East Carolina University and is a S.E. Shires Performing Artist.

**Yolanda Tapia** is an international prize-winning piano soloist and a highly sought-after collaborative pianist. A native of Xalapa, Mexico, she has performed concertos with Xalapa Symphony Orchestra and Colorado State University Symphony Orchestra and performed at the Académie Musicale de Morges in Switzerland. Yolanda holds a Doctor of Musical Arts from Western University and was a Fulbright Scholar during 2012-14.

**Calvin Dvorsky** is an undergraduate student of composition at Western University. He has been composing from a young age, which has let him develop a wide and multifaceted personal style. This style ranges from soft and emotive explorations of sound, to raucous and fun pieces filled with energy.
