Guillaume LEKEU (1870-1894) Jordan Clayton is a young, passionate violinist and violin teacher based in London, ON. He holds a Master's Degree in Violin Performance from Western University, which he completed in 2017 under acclaimed violinist, Annette-Barbara Vogel. Jordan performs regularly as a chamber musician with Magisterra Soloists, an exciting new Canadian string ensemble which he helped to establish in 2015 under Annette-Barbara Vogel's founding direction. Jordan serves currently as the ensemble's Outreach Coordinator.

Alongside his work as a private teacher, Jordan is on faculty at the Forest City School for Talent Education, where he serves as the Junior Orchestra Conductor and as a violin instructor for the junior violin classes. Jordan will also be serving on faculty for his third consecutive year at the Camp Musical de Québec (Québec, QC) this coming summer of 2018.
