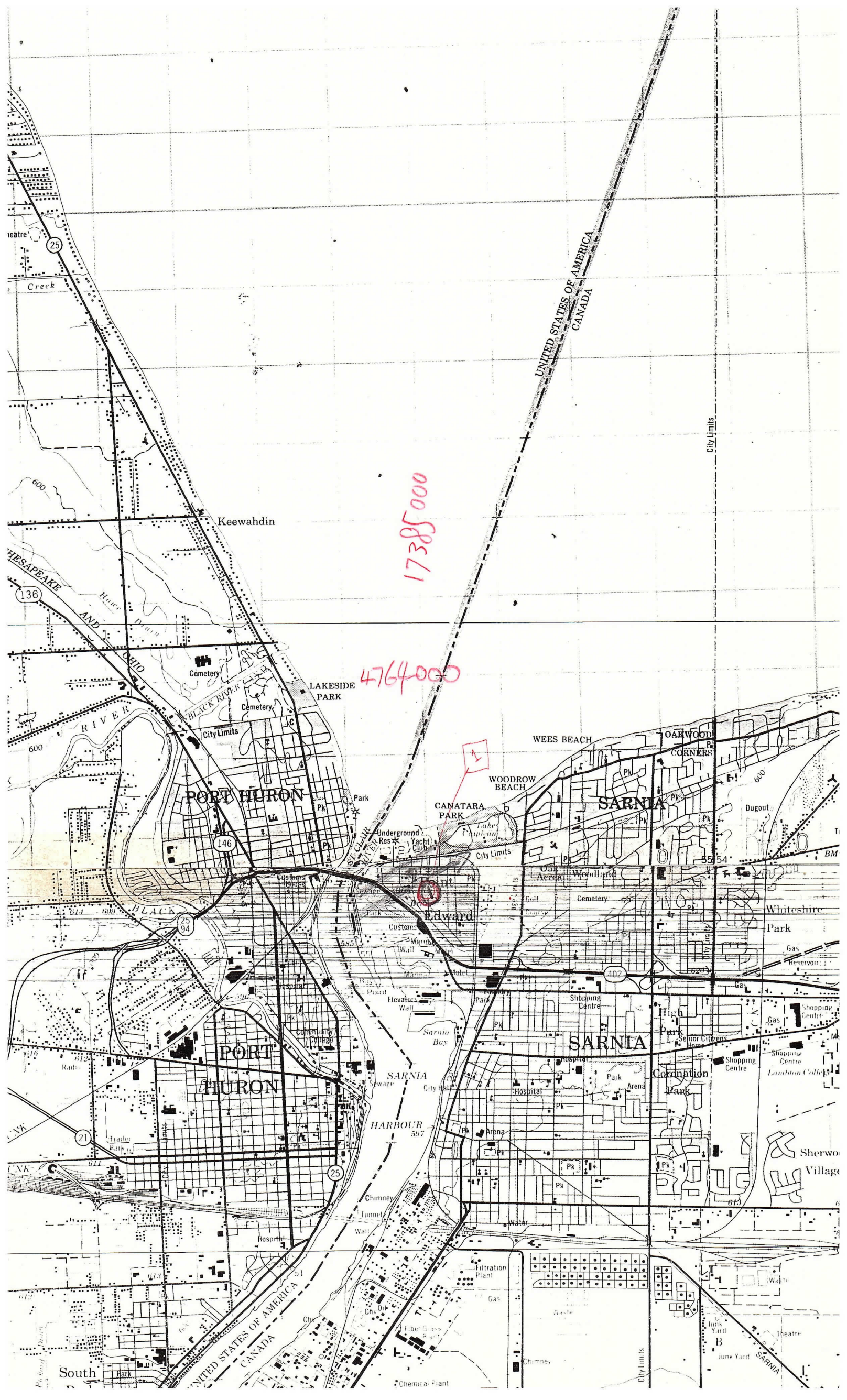

JOHN TELFORD WAS RESTING NR ^{HIS} FRONT DOOR (FACING WEST)
AT 6.30 AM EST WHEN A BRANCH STRUCK HIS FRONT
DOOR - HE RUSHED OUT AND OBSERVED ^{TO THE NW} A LARGE
COLUMNAR SHAPED BLACK CLOUD PROTRUDING
DOWN AND SWWD FROM THE BOTTOM OF A BLACK
CLO. IT WAS ROTATING CLOCK WISE AS IT RETREATED
INTO THE NORTHEAST. IT WAS STRETCHED OUT ALMOST
HORIZONTALLY AND REMINDED HIM OF SMOKE FROM
A LARGE STACK. HE ESTIMATED THE CLOUD DIAM
AT 4 BLOCKS. THE WIND AT THE TIME WAS
RAISING THE SHINGLES ON THE HOUSE ACROSS THE
STREET BUT DID NOT REMOVE ANY.
