## ALUMNI CONCERT DIRECTORS

### Carol Beynon, BMusA'71, DipEd'72, MEd'83 - Conductor

Carol Beynon is professor emerita in Music Education at Western and served in several senior administrative roles, including Associate Vice Provost of the School of Graduate & Postdoctoral Studies and acting Dean of the Faculty of Education. She is the founding co-artistic director of the renowned and award-winning Amabile Boys & Men's Choirs of London, Canada. Carol is the first author of the book *Learning to Teach* (2001) and co-editor of *Critical Perspectives in Canadian Music Education* (2012). Carol is a specialist in vocal and choral development and serves as a clinician and adjudicator for national and international conferences and music festivals. She has received several awards for outstanding teaching and was named the Woman of Excellence in Arts, Culture and Heritage in London, Ontario and community. In 2010, Carol was inducted into the "Alumni Wall of Fame" at the Don Wright Faculty of Music at Western.

### Bob Anderson, BMus'77, BEd'78 – Conductor

Bob Anderson taught in the Peel District School Board for 25 years, joining the staff of Cawthra Park Secondary School in 1999, retiring in 2016. At Cawthra Park SS, Bob taught vocal and instrumental music in the Regional Arts Program and conducted the Cawthra Park Chamber Choir, which has performed with the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Cirque du Soleil, the Elmer Iseler Singers, several festivals, and in 2013 at the Air Canada Centre in Toronto with The Rolling Stones. He also conducted Cawthra's 350-voice concert choir, "The Ritz". In 2015, Bob was invited by Choirs Ontario to conduct the Ontario Youth Choir, a one-week program of intensive choral training for high school and university students from across Ontario.

### Debbie Grigg, BMus'79, MMus'14 - Accompanist

Debbie Grigg taught at Woodstock International School in Mussoorie, India, Crofton House School for Girls in Vancouver and also taught music in elementary schools for Middlesex County from 1987-96. Since 1997, she worked primarily as collaborative accompanist in the London area, presently at Medway High School and at the Faculty of Music at Western.
