GALE RENDS CHURCH, TEACHER'S COOLNESS SAVES LITTLE GIRLS.. FORT WILLIAM
VISITED BY HEAVIEST THUNDERSTORM OF SEASON.

FORT WILLIAM, SEPT. 24. The most severe thunderstorm of the season, though it was of short duration, visited this city this afternoon. Curiously enough, it was not heavy in PORT ARTHUR, 3½ miles away.

At 3 o'clock the SWEDISH LUTHERAN CHURCH was virtually demolished, and 35 children, all girls, attending public school classroom in the church basement, had a remarkable escape from death or injury, the coolness of the teacher, MISS B. MCKENZIE, averting a panic. The rending timbers and creaking walls caused the children to scream in terror. Two carpenters working on the roof were catapulted across a nearby building, but suffered only minor injuries and shock.

The steeple was torn asunder and the front of the building was torn out. Plate glass in houses for yards around was smashed.
