Joan Andrews grew up in Ottawa and graduated from the University of Western Ontario as a specialist in Music Education. She then began a thirty-one year career as a vocal and instrumental music teacher with the Scarborough Board of Education and ultimately became head of the music department at Dr. Norman Bethune Collegiate Institute.

For forty years she has been a member of the Amadeus Choir of Greater Toronto in which she sings soprano and is assistant conductor. After retiring from teaching, she conducted the Village Voices community choir in Markham for 17 years. As an accomplished flutist, she is a member of The Encore Symphonic Concert Band, which is made up mainly of retired professional musicians like herself. Joan feels very privileged to have been asked to play a key role in the function honouring her beloved professor, Don McKellar.
