## Storm Kills David Lock, 52

INNERKIP, Ont. — A severe wind and rain storm that cut a narrow swath through this district last night brought death to David E. Lock, 52, prominent Blandford farmer, injury to his small grandson, and left a trail of damaged roofs and badly flattened crops.

Mr. Lock was killed about 7.45 p.m. when a tree under which he had pulled his car for shelter in the height of the storm crashed down.
