Amadeus Guitar Duo

Dale Kavanagh (Canada) and Thomas Kirchhoff (Germany) have been playing together since 1991. Many composers have dedicated works to the Amadeus Duo since then, such as Stephen Dodgson, Gerald Garcia, Harald Genzmer, Jaime Zenamon, Roland Dyens, Stephen Funk-Pearson, Christian Jost, Carlo Domeniconi a.o. The duo often performs with orchestras, playing concertos by Joaquin Rodrigo, Roland Dyens, Genzmer, Carlo Domeniconi, Jaime Zenamon, Gerald Garcia, Christian Jost and Martin Herchenröder. They have given more than 1,000 concerts in 60 European countries, Asia and North and South America in the last 20 years, and have recorded 16 CDs (*Haenssler Classic*). They are invited to play in the United States, Canada, China, South Korea, Thailand, England, Italy, Spain, Turkey, Rumania, Greece and Germany in the 2014/15 season.

Dale and Thomas have established one of the largest and most prestigious guitar festivals in Europe, the International Guitar Symposium Iserlohn (www.guitarsymposium.com). Dale Kavanagh, Thomas Kirchhoff and their daughter Melissa Rachel are residents of Iserlohn, Germany. Amadeus Guitar Duo plays exclusively D'Addario Composite strings and guitars by Antonius Muller, Aarbergen and Kenny Hill, San Francisco.
