## One Dead, Child Hurt In Storm at Ottawa

### Widespread Destruction as Crops Flattened and Orchards Stripped

Ottawa, July 15 (CP).—One person killed, a child slightly injured, and widespread destruction of farm out-buildings, trees and growing crops resulted from a sudden wind and electric storm which tore a path down the Ottawa Valley today.

Farmers tonight were counting their losses in the shape of unroofed barns, smashed windows, and destroyed orchards.

Lightning struck from a leaden sky at Montebello, Que., about forty miles east of Ottawa, killing instantly Philippe Thomas, aged 22, only son of Mr. and Mrs. Xavier Thomas, as he rode with his father on a load of hay. The father was unhurt, as were the horses. The hay did not catch fire.

← Almost simultaneously, at Fassett, Que., a short distance from Montebello, Real Lalonde, aged 11, son of Mr. and Mrs. Philippe Lalonde, was struck to the ground by another bolt of lightning. He proved, however, to be superficially injured.
