STORM DATE. TUES. AUGUST 17TH. 1937.

SEVERE STORM IN THIS DISTRICT.

Wind of cyclonic proportions on Tuesday of last week caused considerable damage in PEEL where telephone poles were blown down and at least one barn, owned by RUSSEL SMITH on the 16TH. CONCESSION, was carried away by the wind. Doors from another barn owned by JOHN McNABB were torn off and carried a considerable distance from the building. In ROTHSAY a chimney was blown off L.V. DELMAGE'S STORE and shingles were torn off several barns in the district. Orchards also suffered. Hail flattening many fields and damage is estimated at several thousands dollars.
