
F2 Tornado in Guelph - June 30/98

SUMMARY

This event occurred on June 30th, 1998 at 10:00 UTC in <u>Guelph</u>, <u>Ontario</u>. There were no reports of hail and no tornados were sighted, however tornadic damage was verified in the area. From this damage it is estimated that a tornado of F2 intensity on the Fujita Scale, touched down in the vicinity of southern Guelph. The tornadao's damage path tracked eastward for approximately one kilometer before lifting back to the cloud base. Minor damage was inflicted upon several homes and many large trees were split and knocked over. There was a lack of general wind damage in the neighborhood, although there were three severe, isolated damage sites along the tornado's 1km track.






Three houses in a row on the west side of Edinburgh Road (starting from the right side of the left photo above: No's 545,547 & 549) had extensive roof damage. The home's shingles were completely ripped off as well as substantial sections of the roof's underlay. Some of the contents of the top floors were even removed and deposited in the yards. A metal picnic table was removed from a back deck and was lost. That is to say that it could not be found in the immediate vicinity of the homes nor anywhere else at last report. Four large trees across the road were twisted and toppled over.







Some missing shingles and siding on a house at Gryphon Place, about 100 meters east of the first event.
