Hi Victoria: Ray Wallace couldn't remember when the storm was in August, so I call the people who farm his father-in-law's property. I spoke to Mrs. Frances Cathcart.

She said her husband and son were out baling hay that night and it was storming, "It started at the Boothman's she said, it come over the hill to Mackenzie's, took a maple tree off, then came across to Steve and Donna Houseman's and Allan Carthcarts. Robert has corn in the field and it put a hole in Robert's corn field, he has no insurance. It took a tree down, then it came across to Mercer Road and took 2 cedar trees out and put them across the road. Nobody could go to work. Bruce cut them off. Then it went across to Tommy's (Rays In-laws) and twisted the round tree. Tommy has a tree in the field that Doug calls the round tree because he always has to work around it. It knocked a limb off the round tree but it didn't take it down. It tipped tree trees over onto the electric fence and took down 14 trees at Henderson's."

It happened on August 20th, because Frances plays cards at the Kendal Community Centre every other Thursday night. She come home early that Thursday night because the power went off in the hall - caused by trees falling onto the hydro wires which started a bit of a fire. Doug asked her when she came home, why she was home so early? She replied, "Because you can't play cards in the dark, silly?" There you have it.

Hi Victoria: I'm not sure I got an exact date. The line of damage was from west to slightly north of east, and they were all laying in the same direction. There was water in a ditch on the north edge of the field but I don't think it was swampy. I took the pictures Saturday morning, and it had rained quite a bit on Friday. The downed trees did look healthy. I'm not good with estimating distance. It was a small field, the corner of a field actually. In picture 9307 you can see Thertell Rd. - the east/west road, and Langstaff Rd. the north/south road, I was standing in the pasture to the west of the field, the green angle iron is part of the fence line.

I am trying to call Ray Wallace to confirm the date, but the phone is busy.

I'll keep trying.
