

FEES

Fees are paid in full on registration day, but if necessary they may be divided after consultation with the Comptroller, into two instalments payable on the first day of each term. The extra charge for this division is \$5.00. Students must pay their fees as above before attending any lectures or examinations, except by permission of the Dean of the Faculty and the Comptroller. No student shall be recommended for any diploma or degree until his tuition fees and other accounts owed to the University are paid.

The Board of Governors reserves the right to amend fees after the printing of this list.

Annual Tuition and Prescribed Accessory Fees

For FULL-TIME intramural undergraduate students

(this annual sum includes registration, regular examination and graduation fees, laboratory and microscope charges, University College Council, University Concert Series, Athletic Association, Thames Hall facilities and Students' Health Insurance and Health Service fees, for the following courses):
