Developing Self-Regulated Learners provides a balanced examination of theory and practice. The authors engage with research from leading figures in the field (e.g., Bandura, Zimmerman, Schunk, Pintrich, Harris, Graham, Winne), as well as the work of well-respected Canadian researchers (e.g., Butler, Cartier, Winne, Perry, & Hadwin), in order to provide the reader with practical recommendations for creating safe and supportive learning environments, creating opportunities for self-regulation, and using assessment to empower learning. In addition, the authors do an excellent job addressing the importance of supporting the development of self-regulated learning across the lifespan. Each chapter is anchored in a review of the material presented in previous chapters, which helps situate the material and provides the necessary context to delve into new content. This text is well an organized, succinct, and well-written text. The included vignettes provide a rich background for the reader to envision self-regulated learning in practice and build on this contextual knowledge as they dove into a deeper theoretical understanding of this topic. The authors provide an in-depth exploration of self-regulated learning, while maintaining an ease of readership for pre-service or in-service teachers.
